Please note the day's schedule and events:

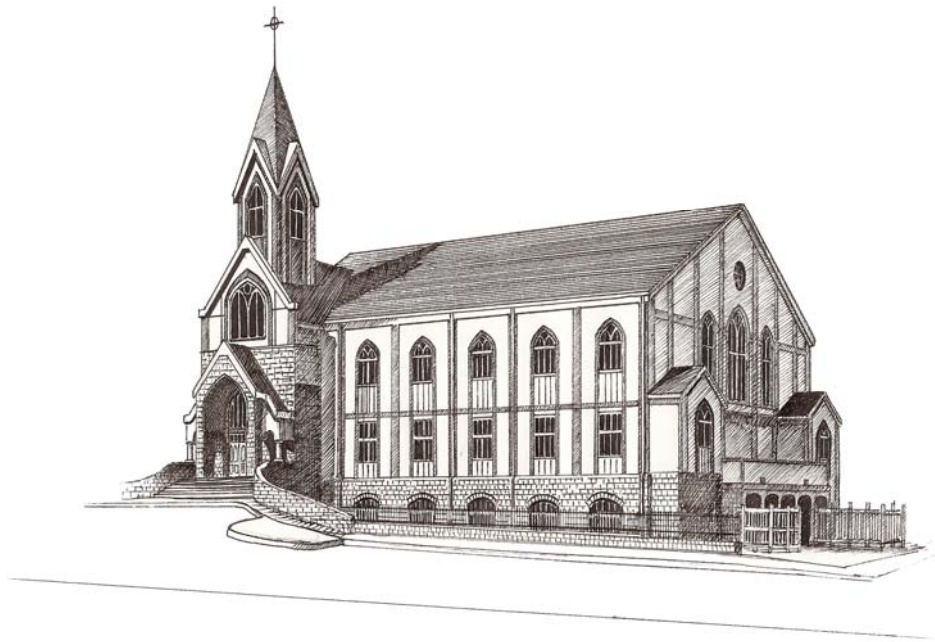
- **10:00** – In lieu of Sunday School, there will be an **Opening Exercise in the 1987 sanctuary** followed by the Decoration of Graves.
